

Camper Rules

- Follow the camp schedule and participate in all camp activities.
- **Wash your hands with soap and water** before every meal, when you go to/from each activity, and after using the restroom.
- **DRINK PLENTY OF WATER.** Make sure you are drinking enough water. Watch out for dehydration.
- **Shower daily & wear deodorant.** Your friends and leaders will thank you 😊
- Do not change your housing assignment or move your bed.
- Everyone must be fully dressed when going to/from the showers in the gym; and to/from the pool.
- Respect any “off limit” areas and each nightly curfew.
- Stay out of other genders’ designated areas [ie: bunkhouses, cabins, restrooms]
- No PDA [Public or Private Displays of Affection]. No purpling!
- Alert an Adult Staff member if you see a wild animal [bear, bobcat, snake, etc...]. **DO NOT approach any wildlife.**
- Do not enter the kitchen unless invited by an adult from the kitchen staff.
- **DO NOT** be alone with any member of the opposite gender at any time. This is **STRICTLY** enforced.
- Stay out of other genders’ designated areas [ie: bunkhouses, cabins, restrooms].
- During times of worship, no guy-girl contact [with non-family members].
- Wear **closed-toe shoes**, appropriate clothing, and always follow the dress code.
- Do not lose your water-bottle. **DRINK PLENTY OF WATER.** Only put water in your water-bottles and use it only for drinking.
- Do not share any medicines of any kind; natural; over-the-counter; or prescriptions.
- **WEAR YOUR BUTTON ON YOUR SHIRT.** Do not lose your name button; your button will be your meal ticket at every meal. If you don’t have it, you will go to the back of the line. Replacements are limited.
- Report any sickness or injuries immediately to an Adult Staff member.
- Respect all Junior Staff and Adult Staff.
- Do not say or write anything inappropriate on someone’s t-shirt.
- Do not draw on your skin, or the skin of other people.
- Respect your peers. This includes their person, and their belongings. No pranks.
- Help keeping the campground, bunkhouses, cabins, and bathrooms clean. If you see trash, pick it up, and throw it away.
- Do not take anything that doesn’t belong to you.
- **DRINK PLENTY OF WATER.**
- Have fun, be safe, and help others stay do the same!
- **LOST and FOUND:** If you find anything that does not belong to you, take it to the box in the center of the main stage in the cafeteria.
